"Thank you for having me come down south for Sunshine! It was a delight and honor to judge this entry that, though small, was deep in quality. The temperaments of the Pembrokes were all good and the sportsmanship of the exhibitors outstanding. Good type was abundant in the entry and generally my decisions were based on virtues present in structure and movement. My top winners all had beautiful expressions, excellent outlines and showed balance and ease of motion. As I mentioned at the reception, I hope we pass to younger exhibitors and breeders our knowledge of not only what we treasure in type and expression in our Pembrokes but also what correct structure is. Balance is essential for correct structure. A good shoulder is a treasure especially when combined with a correct and equal turn of stifle. Good movement is not fast and flashy. It is effortless and easy. I see so much in all-breed shows, breeds that lack that correct shoulder but with a well angulated rear and lots of conditioning and energy - can look like they can move. If only for a few circuits of the ring. I was delighted to find that in this small entry, I still found correct shoulders and balance that lead to beautiful Pembrokes that could trot all day to do the job they were meant to do.

Thank you for letting me go over your beautiful Pembrokes. It was a privilege."
