Thus, the officers and board currently <----- listed will continue to serve through the club year July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026.

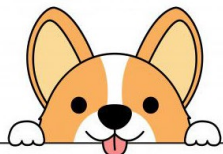
A big thank you to those who take the time to help advance the cause and focus of our Corgi club.

We have our specialty coming up in July at WEC. It's a good time but we need volunteers to help out. No experience needed!

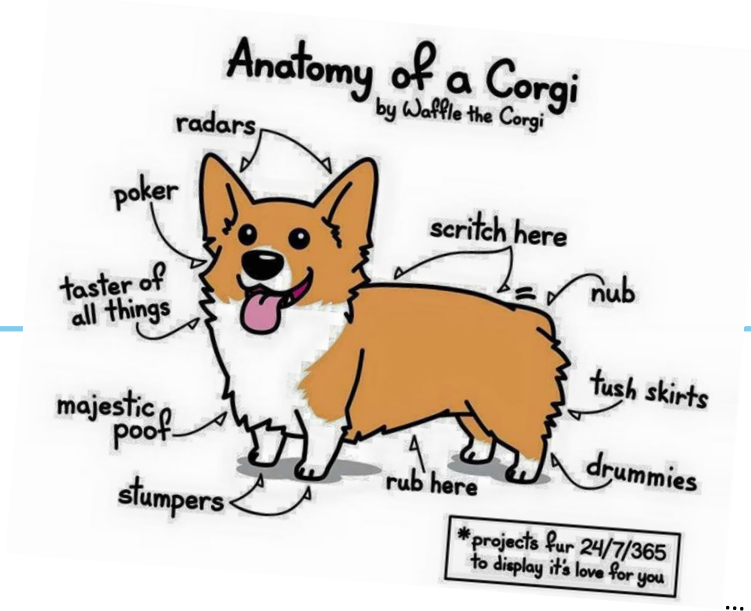
