BEWARE OF SCAM E-MAIL MESSAGES

SPWCC is reminding you that e-mail scams and hoaxes are overtaking world of dogs.

Most of us have received scam e-mails from “club officers” for several years. It’s now hitting members of other clubs and the AKC. Remember to look carefully at the e-mail address before opening any e-mail that contains the name of a friend or associate.

Remember, it’s easy to miss subtle changes to e-mail addresses. Consider substituting the number ‘ 1 ’ for the letter ‘ l ’. Obvious for Arial font. Can you see the difference when using Times New Roman (used in this newsletter) between the letter “ l ” and number “ 1 ?” I can’t !!! They are identical. So don’t use Times for your font in your E-Mail program !!!

Opening, even accidentally, such an e-mail or clicking on an attachment or link, can release tiny computer programs that can transmit all your contacts to a hacker who will then generate fake e-mails to all your friends. ***If you’re asked for money or anything urgent, STOP !!!***

Delete any suspicious e-mails so that you don’t infect your computer. And initialize scams that affect your friends and family.

The Florida Legislature has given final approval to a consumer protection bill that also includes non-controversial elements of amended breeder-focused legislation.

History

The American Kennel Club (AKC) and the Florida Association of Kennel Clubs (FAKC) [expressed significant concerns with House Bill 1521](#) as introduced, which would have required (1) Florida dog breeders and dog breeding facilities to register with the state, (2) the creation of “best management practices” regulations, (3) annual and complaint-based inspections of dog breeders, and (4) the creation of a whistleblower program.

Advocacy efforts of AKC, FAKC, and allied stakeholders resulted in significant amendments to HB 1521, including changing the required breeder registration and regulations to a voluntary program.

As the legislative session has neared its adjournment, further amended language from HB 1521 was incorporated into an amended version of another bill, [Senate Bill 1004](#), which originally sought to update consumer protections for Floridians who purchase pets from “pet dealers.” Because the Florida Senate had already approved SB 1004, the bill received final legislative approval when the Florida House unanimously passed amended SB 1004 late Monday, March 9th.

Summary of the Legislation

As passed, the legislation reflects a significantly narrowed approach compared to earlier versions of HB 1521. The final bill directs the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation to develop and publish a list of voluntary best practices related to animal adoption, breeding, and care. Importantly, the final version removes the creation of a formal regulatory program, instead focusing on voluntary guidance and recommendations for stakeholders.

For purposes of the consumer protection law, the bill also increases the sales thresholds to qualify as a *pet dealer*, to three litters sold per year (from two) or 30 dogs sold per year (from 20).

Next Steps

SB 1004 will now be sent to Governor DeSantis for enactment or veto. AKC will continue to monitor the measure and provide updates as developments occur. Florida’s 2026 regular legislative session is scheduled to adjourn on Friday, March 13th, though it will likely reconvene soon afterward to continue work on finalizing the state’s budget.

An amendment to the House Farm Bill (HR 7567) proposed by animal rights groups threatens the future of AKC performance events and recognized hunt training techniques.

Please join AKC and leading sportsmen's organizations in defending responsible dog enthusiasts, sportsmen and trainers. **Please contact your member of the U.S. Congress and respectfully ask Congress to remove language derived from the "Greyhound Protection Act of 2025" (HR 5017) from the Farm Bill before final passage.**

Why This Matters

While the stated intent of the Greyhound Protection Act is to address concerns related to commercial greyhound racing, the provision attached to the Farm Bill is overly broad and risks eliminating or banning standard training and event practices for certain field trials, performance events, lawful hunting with dogs, and other widely accepted training methods used by responsible dog owners and handlers.

In fact, the amendment goes well beyond "commercial" greyhound racing – which currently only exists in one state; it also bans live lure training, use of live lures, and open field coursing events involving live animals.

Because these terms lack clear statutory definitions, they could be interpreted in ways that affect lawful hunting activities and traditional dog training methods. For example, controlled exposure to live birds, or other game animals, is a widely accepted and essential component of preserving unique breed characteristics and training bird dogs, retrievers, hounds, and other working dogs. Dog trainers and hunters commonly use farm-raised birds such as pigeons, ducks, or pheasants to teach scent recognition, steadiness, retrieval skills, and humane handling of game. These practices help ensure that hunting dogs perform their work effectively and minimize harm to wildlife during hunts.

Without clear exemptions, prohibiting the use of live animals in canine events that showcase breed characteristics, responsible hunting, or dog training could effectively eliminate long-standing, responsible training methods.

These restrictions could easily be interpreted or amended to severely impact or eliminate:

- Field trials,
- Hunt tests,
- Earthdog competition,



Take Action !!!

The Farm Bill is a massive bill that authorizes policy and funding for agriculture for the next 5 years. Because it impacts the critical needs of farmers, rural communities, forestry, conservation, etc., it is considered a "must pass" bill by Congress.

For bills that have not been able to gain traction as stand-alone legislation, the Farm Bill's "must pass" status provides activists with an attractive, alternative vehicle for passage that bypasses regular channels. Bills that push the animal rights agenda, for example, often latch onto the Farm Bill as a vehicle, despite being at odds with the Bill's fundamental goals.

Wednesday was the last day that amendments to the House version of the Farm Bill could be filed before the bill moves to the floor of the U.S. House of Representatives for a vote later this month. More than 300 amendments were filed – many that are divisive and could undermine the important purpose and goals of the Farm Bill.

Anyone who supports the health and wellbeing of animals and the human animal bond and believes that public policy should not be based on ideology, should seek a clean Farm Bill that is not burdened by having a bunch of damaging amendments attached to it

So here's our simple recommendation. In your own words, write to your Congress member ([get their contact information here](#)) and urge them to pass a clean Farm Bill, one that does not include divisive amendments that will weaken its passage, such as:

- **Amendment 11 filed by Reps. Fitzpatrick (PA) and Panetta (CA) – “Puppy Protection Act”**
- **Amendment 18 filed by Reps. Krishnamoorthi (IL), Lawyer (NY), Titus (NV), Mace (SC), and Thanedar (MI) – “Animal Welfare Enforcement Improvement Act”**
- **Amendment 30 filed by Reps. Mace (SC) and Titus (NV) – “Violet’s Law”**
- **Amendment 135 filed by Reps. Quigley (IL), Malliotakis (NY), and Buchanan (FL) – “Goldie’s Act”**

Many of the harmful amendments that affect our membership duplicate what USDA is already doing — and doing well — and are drafted using inflexible, “gotcha” provisions rather than ones that have proved to be effective in actually improving animal welfare outcomes.

In proper terms, these amendments often promote rigid engineering standards versus performance-based standards. Engineering standards offer one-size-fits-all-type solutions to problems that require flexibility. Not only individual animals, but individual circumstances need to be considered when drafting policy for animals.

Tell them:

1. You are a voting constituent (including city/town you live in) and a responsible dog enthusiast.
2. Respectfully ask them to oppose overly broad language from the Greyhound Protection Act (HR 5017) that has been added to the Farm Bill.
3. Explain that it does nothing to improve the wellbeing of dogs, and as written could ban or lead to bans on responsible dog training practices that are essential to developing well trained working and performance dogs, as well as popular responsible dog events in the community. Share your positive experiences with these events, if appropriate.
4. Note that the Farm Bill is one of the most important and broadly supported pieces of legislation considered by Congress. It should not become the vehicle for language that disrupts lawful hunting traditions, events that showcase breed characteristics, responsible dog ownership, and established canine training practices nationwide.

The American Kennel Club has received multiple reports of fraudulent emails, text messages, and phone calls impersonating AKC leadership, including President and CEO Gina DiNardo and, in some cases, individual AKC staff.

These scams attempt to pressure recipients into sending money (often via gift cards, wire transfers, or payment apps) or sharing sensitive personal or financial information. While the messages may appear convincing, **they are fraudulent.**

AKC leadership and staff will never:

Request payment via gift cards, wire transfers, cryptocurrency, or payment apps such as CashApp, Zelle, or Venmo

- Ask for personal or financial information via unsolicited email, text message, or voicemail
- Send unsolicited messages urging you to click links or open “urgent” or “secure” documents
- Ask you to keep a request confidential or pressure you to act immediately

Important note:

In limited, legitimate cases, AKC staff may contact clubs regarding an existing, known transaction or invoice. These communications will **never** involve unusual payment methods, secrecy, or urgency. When in doubt, always hang up and contact AKC directly using a trusted phone number or email address.

If you receive a suspicious message, **do not respond, do not click links, and delete it immediately.**

Expanding Threats: AI-Driven and Pretexting Scams

Scammers are increasingly using **artificial intelligence** and **pretexting (social engineering)** to make scams more convincing. These attacks may arrive via **text message, phone call, voicemail, or even video chat**, often using urgency or authority to manipulate recipients.

Common warning signs:

- Unexpected contact claiming an emergency or urgent issue
- Requests that bypass normal processes
- Pressure to act quickly or keep the request confidential
- Requests for money or sensitive information

Always verify before taking action. If something feels off, pause and independently confirm the request using known contact information.



Protecting Yourself and Your Club

- Verify all financial or sensitive requests through trusted channels
- Never share personal or financial information without confirmation
- Avoid clicking links or opening attachments in unexpected messages
- Review social media privacy settings—scammers may use audio or video clips to impersonate others
- Periodically review and reinforce your club's financial controls

Additional guidance is available from the **Federal Trade Commission (FTC)**, and clubs are encouraged to review the [Managing Club Finances](#) resources to ensure strong safeguards are in place.

While these threats continue to evolve, awareness and verification remain the most effective defenses. Thank you for helping protect yourself, your club, and the integrity of AKC programs.

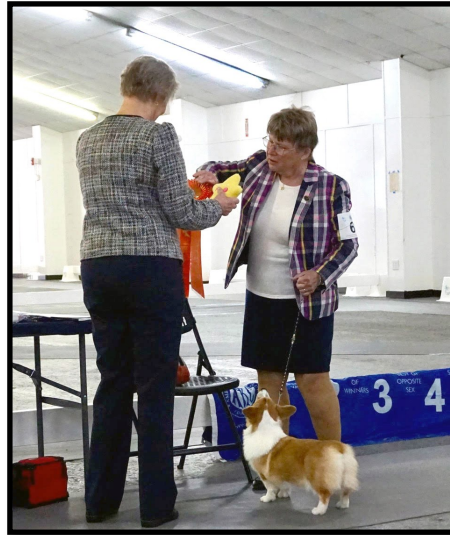

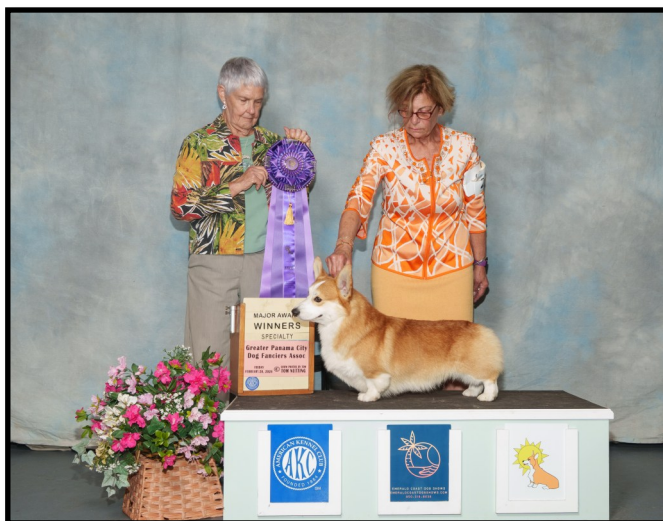
