In recent weeks, though, *"we were this close"* took a whole new and, frankly, more significant meaning. And a few of our members are grateful it wasn't closer!

Julia Clough, whom I have the pleasure of knowing both here in Florida as well as Maine, can say that. The EF2 tornado that struck Martin County on Wednesday afternoon on October 9, passed less than 50 feet from her townhouse. Julia was unconcerned about having no electricity for almost 5 days. She has no air conditioning in her York, Maine farm house where heat and humidity can still roast for days there several times a summer. And it was a great excuse to go out to eat at one of the many fine restaurants in nearby Stuart that weren't affected by the outage! Invitations to join us at our home, unaffected by the tornado (though it passed less than a mile away), were graciously declined.

We are all grateful that none of our friends and club members were harmed. Clearly, it's fortunate "we were this close" and no closer!



You've Got Mail !

OK, so maybe you didn't have AOL in the days when those words announced the arrival of an e-mail. I did, but I'm not telling you how long ago that was!!!

Today, it's a ding, or a tone you oten choose on your phone. And you look, and it's Grace Carter asking if you have time right now! OR IS IT?

With today's proliferation of scams, viruses, malware, etc. you really have to be careful. We're not getting any younger and it's harder to keep up with the latest, greatest scams. So here's a lesson from someone who's badgered by corporate IT every week to "watch out."

- **SPOOFING:** That e-mail from Grace wasn't from her. The address in the FROM field wasn't hers! We all know her e-mail address has "corgi" in it! I have received, in the last year, at least a dozen e-mails from Grace which were clearly not from her. I trash them and empty the trash promptly. You should too!
- **PHISHING:** Got an e-mail that says you need to re-enter your Amazon password to reactivate your account? DON'T! Look at the address in the FROM field carefully. If it's a Gmail account, it isn't from Amazon. Or if it's from bank0famerica.com, you're OK, right? Wrong! I put a zero (0) in place of the 'o' in "of" and you might not have noticed that. Look carefully at the FROM field. Substitutions of letters that look similar are hard to see upon quick inspection. Study the e-mail address carefully before acting. Heck, if you bank elsewhere, why is Bank of America sending you an e-mail if it's not just an advertisement! If you do use Bank of America, go to their website and log in. A message from them would also be shown in your account notifications. Surprise, there's nothing there for you, you'll discover! Trash that scam e-mail. And empty the trash.

Never click on a link in an e-mail until you verify the URL (the web address to which you'll be taken). You can see the address if you hover the mouse over the link or right click the link and choose 'display URL.'. If it's really Bank of America, it's far better to log in from the bank website and see the details without touching the link. Scammers can easily install viruses and other little malicious programs like ransomware onto your computer or phone. Or a program that collects data from all your friends! All they need is for you to click that link! DON'T DO IT!!!

If you realize you acted impulsively and gave away valuable information, like a password, immediately go to, say, Bank of America and change your password. Speed at this time is critical. Don't dawdle!

If you clicked on a link you shouldn't have, promptly run an updated virus program scan to see if anything malicious got installed when you clicked that link.



CRUISER (cont'd)

While you may think small shows make it easier to win big, they often include top ranked dogs in the country. Why? Handlers of high-ranked dogs enter these shows to increase their chances of scoring the big prizes, like Group and Show wins. So when you get to Groups or Best-in-Show ring, they're often loaded even if the breed entries are light. Cruiser's results at the Maine shows in June didn't quite match those of the great Aussie "Ribbon," the top-ranked Herding dog in the USA in 2022 and 2023. But they were pretty close! I thought it appropriate to share these great results with our members.
