Exhibitors may enter the Expo 2 Building at 12:00 Noon on Thursday, July 3 (no earlier). Exhibitors are to unload on the North and West sides of the building. Parking is controlled and managed by Site Control Services.

ABSOLUTELY NO UNLOADING ON THE SOUTH END OF EXPO BUILDING 2, AS THIS AREA IS FOR VENDOR'S USE. Vendors may enter the building after 10:00 A.M. on Thursday, July 3.

THERE IS NO CHARGE TO PARK AT WEC.

Admission: Spectator - \$5.00, Seniors 65 & Older \$4.00, Children 12 and under FREE.

Catalogs: \$10.00 for Three Day Cluster.

EXHIBITOR PARKING: Parking for all three days of the Cluster will be directed and managed by Site Control Services.

NO STROLLERS are permitted in Expo Building 2 during show hours for the safety of the children because strollers put dogs at children's eye level with most breeds.

ABSOLUTELY NO GROOMING OR X-PEN SET UPS FROM PARKED VEHICLES.

ABSOLUTELY NO PARKING FOR VANS WITH GENERATORS AROUND EXPO 2 UNLOADING AREAS OR BUILDING ACCESS DOORS. PRIVATE X PENS ARE TO BE SET UP ON THE NORTH SIDE OF EXPO 2 ONLY. DO NOT ALLOW YOUR DOGS TO URINATE OR DEFECATE ON ANY GREENERY AROUND EXPO 2 SO THAT THE BUILDING DOES NOT SMELL LIKE A LATRINE. YOU WILL HAVE TWO X-PENS INSIDE AN AIR CONDITIONED BUILDING AND ARE ALLOWED TO USE YOUR PRIVATE X-PENS ON THE NORTH SIDE OF EXPO 2.

DO NOT PARK ON THE GRASS ANYWHERE ON WEC PROPERTY. YOUR VEHICLES WILL BE TOWED BY WEC AT YOUR EXPENSE. NO WARNINGS, NO EXCEPTIONS.

Dogs should be physically sound. No dog shall be judged if it is taped, bandaged, glued or has stitches anywhere including ears or tail in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the event grounds.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
